



Maru Quevedo is a self-taught photographer who began making art as a teen in Argentina. Quevedo's portraiture work and street photography reflect her desire for connection. "Everything I've had a chance to work on or be a part of is because there's been trust built," says Quevedo. "I think my personality wants more of the connection first until I can go shoot and be comfortable behind the lens with that exchange. That takes time."

These qualities became even more important as Quevedo worked with Local Propagandists in 2020, documenting the protests over police brutality and having conversations about what that meant. "I think it was an interesting time to practice compassion," Quevedo says. "I want to believe that nobody had bad intentions on capitalizing their photography work through social struggle, but I think those conversations were brought up from the commu-



nities that I was from—how are we presenting, what is it we're saying and how [are] we fail[ing]." This insight was not born recently, and the evidence lies in her work.

Quevedo captures what she feels connected to—that means people, places and moments that may be taken for granted. Her Instagram images are banal and lovely, both playing right into and resisting the monotony of the platform. There's a wonderful quality about Quevedo that feels resilient to categorization. "I feel like now I'm at a point that I have the chance to start creating my own projects," Quevedo says. "Am I a photographer? I love to document. My camera has been the tool to express myself. It's been like this for a long time."









SLC punk is alive and well, and this month's Localized Co-headliners The Zissous and MSKING—along with opener #1 Babe Team—are proof. See for yourself for just \$5 at Urban Lounge on March 17 (doors at 7 p.m., music at 8 p.m.), and check out the full features for the co-headliners at SLUGMag.com. Slug Localized is sponsored by Riso-Geist and Uinta Brewing.

The four members of The Zissous ar-■ en't actually family, but they are united in their love for '70s-era punk (and, obviously, Wes Anderson films). "[Our stage names are also a nod to The Ramones, you know, how they all went by Johnny Ramone, Joey Ramone, Dee for themselves in the local music scene.

I've performed my whole life," says Georgina, whose father owned a punk music venue while she was growing up in Wisconsin. "[Casey and I] do stand-up comedy, and I've always done theater and music ... During the pandemic in 2020, Casey bought me a bass for my birthday and taught me how to play." In their debut EP, She-Devil, The Zissous perfectly emulate the retro garage-punk from which they draw their influences, lacing heavy-handed bass and head-bopping guitar riffs with sassy lyrics like "Mama needs her cigarettes."



Sam Johnson frequented *Warped Tour* growing up, while Miranda "Lew" Lewin was "an indie kid." Karlie Bagnani is an elementary school music teacher by day and joins her rockstar bandmates on stage by night. The in-your-face riffs they write are paired with ultra-sensitive lyrics. Even their band name itself showcases the contradicting connotations of "Ms." and "king." But the three-piece is all on the same page where it counts—they're super dedicated to their band and the '90s grunge—inspired tunes they create.

After meeting each other at Westminster College, Johnson and Lewin "bonded over existential dread" and, naturally, formed a band. When Lewin met Bagnani in class—they were both music majors—the stars aligned. "Lew was in the band with me, and then a separate band with Sam. It was

like two overlapping circles of a Venn diagram, which is kind of what we're all about," Lewin says. MSKING began releasing singles in 2019 and most recently released an acoustic EP, *lethologica*, in 2021. As passionate musicians who've all been trained in music theory, the trio has their sights set high—and they're dedicated to reaching the top.

"We've infiltrated each other's dreams at this point," Lewin says. "We know exactly what we want. We want to be a famous band," she says. "We want to be able to sustain ourselves doing what we love."

In doing what they love, MSKING is remarkably intentional every step of the way. In addition to writing poignant punk songs, the trio treats every show as a learning experience.


